Camp Administrator

Andy Mather

Andy Mather will act as the camp administrator. He is the 15's ELITE coach with Beantown VBC and the current Head Coach at Bourne High School. Andy formerly coached the Greater New Bedford boys volleyball team, has coached Regional teams with the Ontario games and both the boys and girls teams in the Massachusetts Summer Bay State Games. He has also coached the mens teams at the University of Rhode Island and M.I.T., and was a former assistant coach with the womens team at Boston College. Andy was the head coach of the mens team at Boston College where they finished in the top 25 Nationally for 10 straight seasons! Over the years, Andy has also coached club teams with the Cape Cod Juniors, Pilgrim and Newton Smash. He has coached boys teams at Millis and Brookline, and girls teams with Oliver Ames, Falmouth, Plymouth South and Medway. He has coached boys and girls teams at Lakeview High School and Fisher Park High School in Ontario, Canada. Most recently, Andy coached the 16's Elite boys team to be the 2016 NERVA Champions.

Premier Coach

Peter Suxho

Peter Suxho is Beantown Volleyball Club's premier coach. He has coached and competed Internationally with the Albania National Team and in the Mediterranean Games. He has coached the Beantown 18's to a Bronze medal in the 2003 USA club championships. Coach Suxho was instrumental in Millis High School's boys and girls volleyball teams going undefeated and winning the State Championships in 2003. He is a certified Level I FIVB coach and is currently the coach of the boys and girls teams at Natick High School. He was Boston Globe's All-Scholastic Coach of the Year in 2006 guiding the boys team to the 2006 State Finals. And in 2007, Coach Suxho once again lead the boys team to the State Championship. Most recently, Peter coached the 18's Elite boys team to be the 2016 NERVA Champions.

Todd Elwell is the current coach of the Boy's 16's Black team Coach Elwell has also coached the 15's Blue and 16's Red for Girls and the 17's Blue team for boys with Beantown VBC. Todd was Boston Globe Coach of the year for the Boys in 2009 for guiding Newton South to the South Sectional finals. He again reached the 2010 Sectional Finals with his boy's team and lead the boys to the State Championship in 2014! Coach Elwell also experienced success with the Girl's team at Newton South winning a MIAA South Sectional Championship in 2008. Todd was recently elected into the MA Girls Volleyball Coaches Hall of Fame.

Kelley Leary is Beantown VBC's coach with the 16's Blue team with the boys and the 18's ELITE team with the girls. Coach Kelley has also worked at many summer volleyball programs and clinics in the New England area and is the Boys and Girl's Coach at Cambridge Rindge and Latin HS. Most recently, Kelley coached the 18's Blue boys team to the 2016 NERVA Silver Bracket Silver medalists!
